- The Maker's Market is an event for Orchard students to create and make items to sell to friends and family for gifts or stocking stuffers.
- Some ideas include: handmade jewelry, art, baked goods, ornaments, a craft kit ready to assemble, etc.
- Encourage your child to use their interests and talents to make their items.
- We ask that you help your child price their items at a price in which it will sell. It can be discouraging to have the item priced too high and not make any sales. The recommended selling price is \$.25-\$3.00.
- Try to have your child make at least 10-15 items to sell.
- Is crafting not your thing? Consider signing up as a family to help staff the hot chocolate booth or the gift wrapping station.
- Please invite your friends, family and neighbors to come do some holiday shopping (while supporting the youth of our community) at this highly anticipated event!

TIPS AND DETAILS

- **When will we set up?** Because it's the same day as makers market there will be some time to set up during the day.
- **What is the price range for items?** \$0.25 to \$5. Obviously, items priced too high may not sell as well.
- **Is this event for the public?** Yes, the public is welcome to come shop at our Market. Orchard families are the Featured sellers at the Market.
- **How do we decide on a price:** In the younger years, rounding up to the next 25 cents above cost is an option. As students get older this event helps teach youth concepts of business. Ultimately, the joy comes from the labor of love and knowing that gifts can be something made not just bought.

OPTIONAL SERVICE STATIONS:

Crafting is not for everyone. Would you enjoy adding to the festive atmosphere? Here are some stations ideas.

-Would you like to run the hot chocolate booth? \$0.50 cent hot chocolate station. Mini cups (Dairy and DF option)

-How about a kid friendly wrapping station for kids to wrap and label what they purchase. Pre-cut squares, tape and scissors.

-Grinch Photo Booth anyone? Costume available. Ideal for family that has someone who wants to dress up and pose with families and run this booth (Previously \$2)

- "Shop for your Mom" table. Items are donated by moms and are priced \$5-\$15 Proceeds from this table are donated to the Orchard. Would include recruiting items from the community.

-Would your family like to prep a hot sandwich to offer to families They would sell. Or sell sliced pizza till it runs out?
